9 Selected Events with a 50% increased point system, will determinate the TCR World Tour. The top **15** drivers will get the entry for the World Final

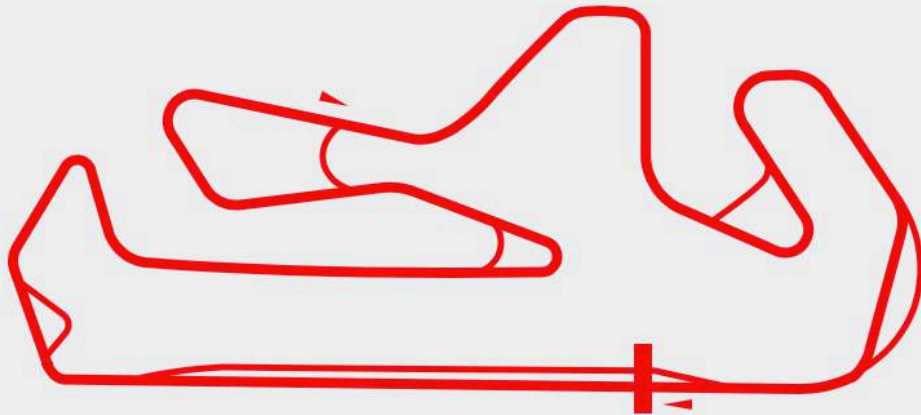

Sporting Info - Regs to released by 10th January 2024



- **Entry fee:** 5.000 euro per car

- **Manufacturers Entry fee:** 15.000 euro (best 6 cars to score points)



- **Max cars allowed:** total of 60 (15 from Kumho TCR WT and 45 drivers from the Priority Lists 1, 2 and 3)



- **Titles:**

Drivers' Champion - to the winner of the Final Race

Teams' Champion - to the entrant of the Final Race winning car.

Manufacturers' Champion - it will be awarded according to the points scored by the first six cars of each Manufacturer

Challengers' Trophy Champion: the best driver among the 45 drivers qualified



- **Prize money:** The value of 500,000 € in tires for the 2024 season will be equally split among the 15 drivers who qualified for the Final through the Play-off Races.

Sporting Format: 45 drivers from TCR World Ranking to play off and 15 drivers for the TCR World Tour already qualified

Each group: n. 1 x 30 min Free Practice + n. 1 x 20 min Qualifying + n.1 x 20 min + 1 lap Race

Race 1: group A vs B

Race 2: group B vs C

Best 15 cars qualified to FINAL

Awarded points:

Qualifying; 3 to 1 to best 3 drivers of each session

Races: 25 to 1 points to be best 15 drivers and 1 point to the one making the fastest lap

TCR World Tour: n. 2 x 30 min Free Practice + n. 1 x 30 min Qualifying

TCR World Ranking Final Qualifying Race: n. 1 x 20 min + 1 lap

Grid: Pole line by TCR WT drivers in Qualy order and second line by Playoff drivers in Qualy order

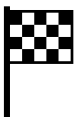
TCR World Ranking Final Repechage Race: n. 1 x 15 min + lap

Grid: all competitors eliminated from the play off, order based by points scored

TCR World Ranking Final Main Race: n. 1 x 30 min + 1 lap

Grid: TCR WT drivers and Playoff drivers in Qualifying Race order + best 4 drivers from Repechage race in last position.

The Champion is the winner of the TCR World Ranking Final Main Race



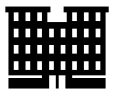
